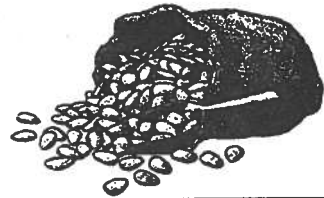

OBJECTIVES

The California Agricultural Statistics Service (CASS) conducted an acreage survey to provide the Almond Board of California (ABC) with current acreage, variety, and year of plant data.

PROCEDURES

Acreage survey preparation was a cooperative effort between the almond, walnut, and prune industries. These industries felt an acreage survey was necessary due to action taken by the California Legislature in 1993 that eliminated funding for collection of acreage data. Due to the enormous number of almond, walnut, and prune growers in California, the survey was designed to operate on a two-year rotational basis with half of almond/walnut/prune growing counties contacted each year (see table back page). In the winter of 1996, seventeen counties were surveyed. These seventeen counties represent approximately half of the almond, walnut, and prune growers in the State.

CASS maintains a fruit data base which served as the main source for questionnaire mailing. Growers on this data base were sent a questionnaire with previously reported crop, variety, trees, acreage, and planting information preprinted. Recipients were asked to update the information. The CASS data base also was compared to the California Department of Pesticide Regulations (DPR) pesticide use permit list and some industry lists. Growers not included in CASS's data base were sent a blank questionnaire and asked to provide specific information on their respective almond, walnut, and/or prune acreage.

Acreage questionnaires were mailed on December 29, 1995. Respondents were given about six weeks to return a response via mail. CASS personnel then conducted telephone follow-ups on non-respondents. Field personnel made personal visits to large growers and those CASS could not contact by mail or telephone. Survey data received on or before May 3, 1996 was edited and included in the final summary. Final analysis and summary work was completed on May 7, 1996.

RESULTS

The almond, walnut, and prune industry showed strong support for the survey. More than 10,000 parcel records were mailed to over 7,000 growers. Overall, the response was excellent with 99 percent of the parcels completed. Of those completed, 44 percent were returned by mail, 40 percent by telephone and 16 percent by personal interview.

In addition, about 400 new parcels were obtained from our list building efforts. Some of the County Agricultural Commissioners sent acreage updates and they are accounted for in this report. Several changes came from Glenn, Fresno, Kern, and Merced counties. Efforts to obtain information from the remaining list and non-respondents continue.

The 1995 California acreage survey results indicate 456,595 total acres of almonds. Of this total, 399,700 acres were bearing and 56,895 acres were non-bearing. The Nonpareil variety accounted for the majority of almond acreage planted at 45 percent of total acreage. The next most common variety was Carmel at 18 percent of total acreage. Kern County shows the largest acreage planted to almonds with 19 percent of total almond acreage. It is closely followed by Merced with 18 percent and Stanislaus with 16 percent of total acreage.

When interpreting data, please keep in mind that the Almond, Walnut, and Prune Acreage Survey was designed to function on a two year cycle. Because only half of the counties are surveyed each year and the time lag in receiving information on new plantings and new growers, we expect the actual plantings, particularly for the non-bearing years, to be higher than what this report shows. These will be reflected in future acreage surveys.

The attached summary tables show results of the acreage survey. These data are for dissemination to the almond industry and other interested parties. Only State and county totals have been published; individual reports remain confidential.

A special thanks goes to the many almond, walnut, and prune farm operators and owners who provided information on their operations. The support was outstanding and we appreciate the time spent completing questionnaires. 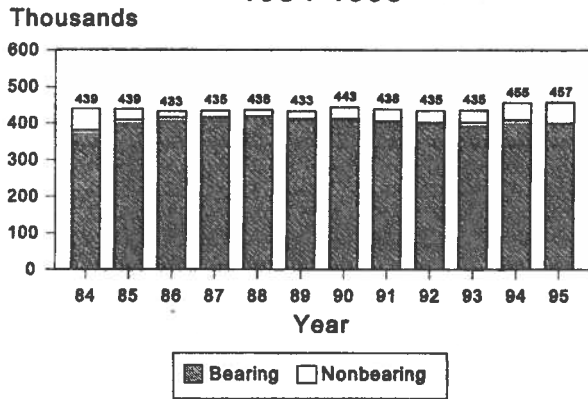
