Weighted average price represents the average roadside price paid to growers and packing houses for fresh Freestone peaches used for freezing or drying. Freezers grading Freestone peaches reported approximately 3.1 percent as off-grade. Dry yards do not grade Freestone peaches, so there is not an off-grade percentage.
