SY Monument Takes Over As Top Variety

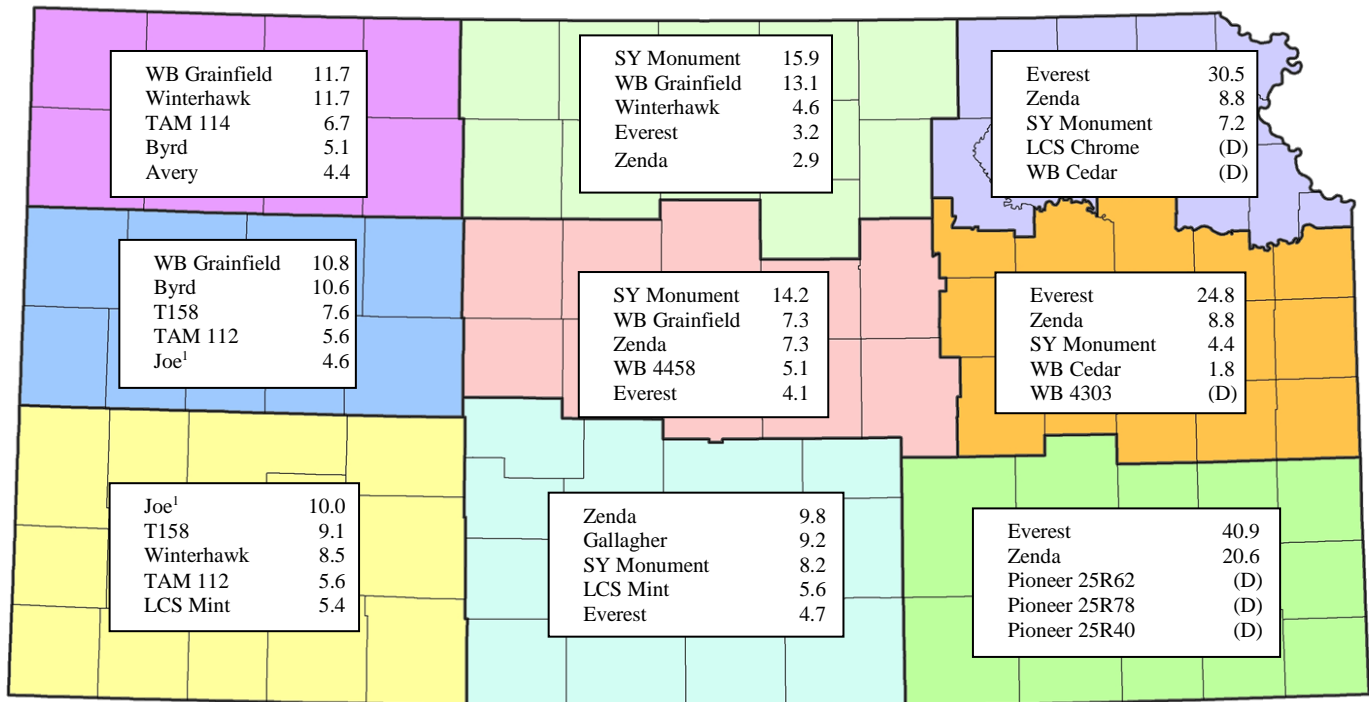
SY Monument, the new leading variety, has seen a gradual increase in overall share of Kansas wheat since 2015, accounting for 7.2 percent of the State's 2019 wheat planted acres. The second most popular variety in 2019 is WB Grainfield at 6.4 percent, which rose from fourth most popular last year. Winterhawk ranked third at 4.8 percent, rebounding from last year's drop in percentage. Zenda, new to the top ten, rose from eighteenth place last year to fourth place at 4.7 percent. Everest dropped to fifth place at 3.8 percent. T158 fell from third place last year to sixth place, also at 3.8 percent. LCS Mint maintained seventh place at 3.3 percent, while falling only slightly in percentage of overall share from last year. Gallagher dropped to eighth place at 2.9 percent, from sixth last year. Joe came in ninth place at 2.6 percent, rising each of the past three years. TAM 114 rounded out the top ten at 2.5 percent.

Area planted with blended varieties was not included in the rankings by variety. Blends accounted for 13.6 percent of the State's planted acreage, which is up from 12.2 percent last year. Hard white varieties accounted for 3.7 percent of the State's acreage, down from 4.7 percent last year. Joe was the leading hard white variety at 2.6 percent, followed by Danby at 0.5 percent.

There were 2,090 positive reports summarized for this year's Wheat Varieties survey.

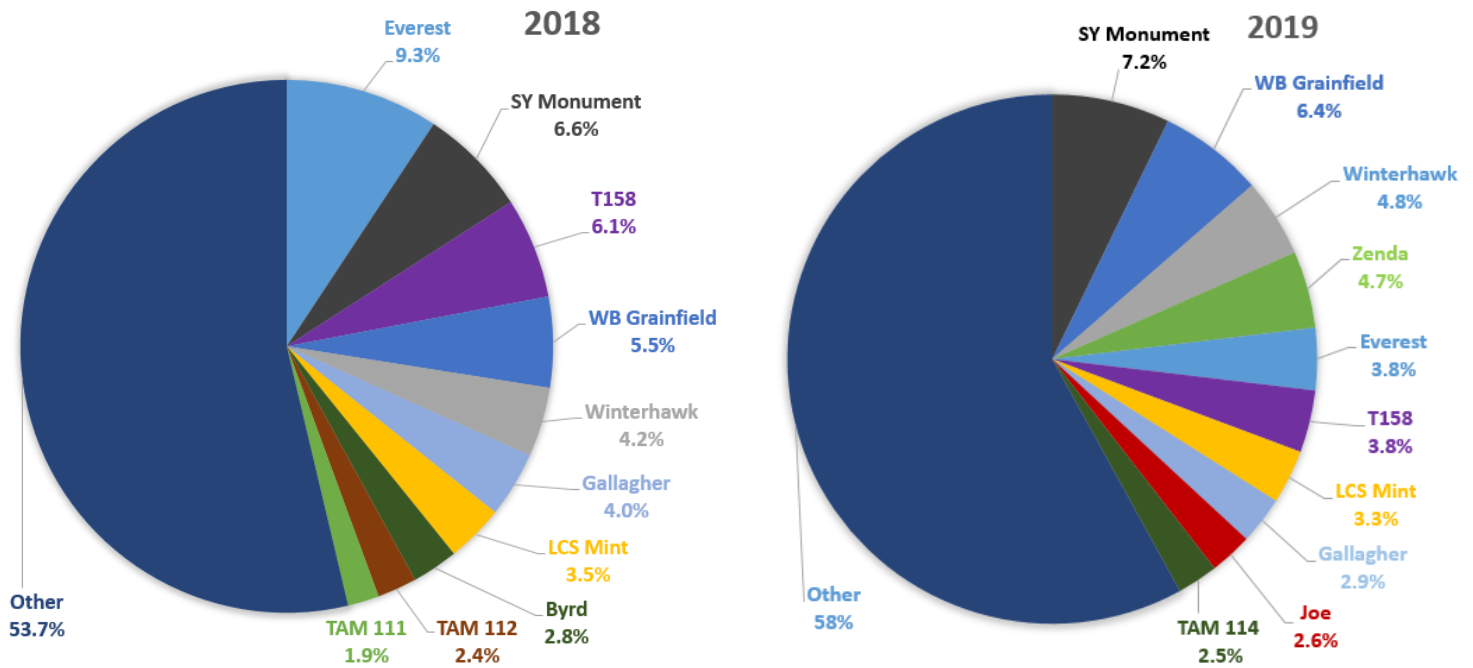
