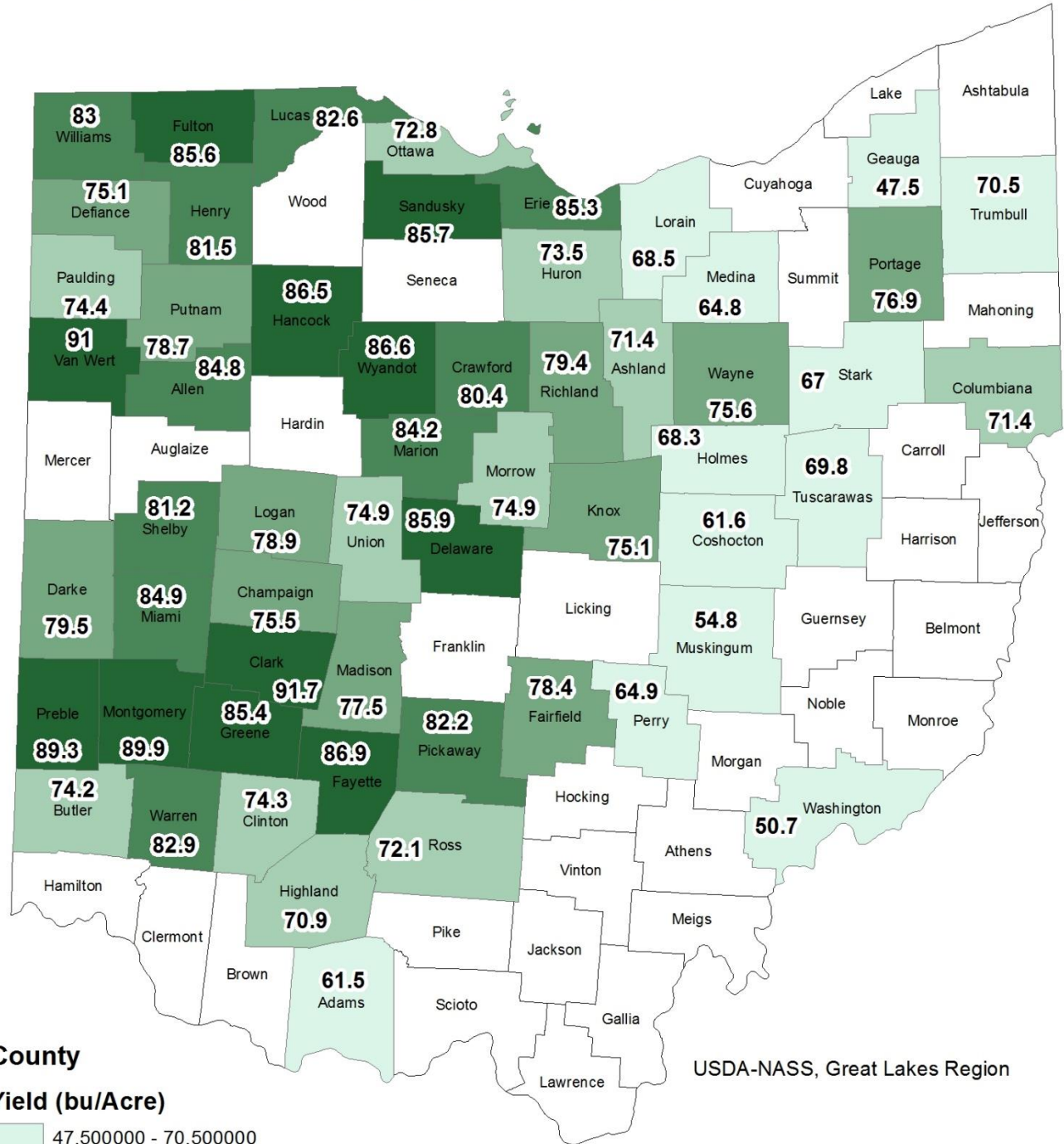

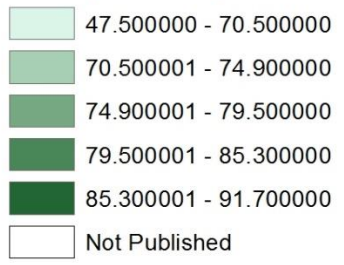
2022 Ohio Winter Wheat Yield
